## Paver Program

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### What is the cost to donate towards a paver?

*Donor's will provide the inscription for their paver for a donation of \$100*

#### Who Benefits from my donation?

*Donations to the Paver program will directly support the Education Foundations (2) Primary programs:*

*Job skills training for those LCMR students entering the workforce after graduation.*

*Annual scholarships for those LCMR students attending secondary education after graduation.*

#### What can be inscribed on a paver?

*A paver has three lines with 14 characters per line. No profanity is allowed and custom characters and designs are not available at this time. The inscriptions are public in nature and intended for visitors to the school campus. Therefore, no private or coded inscriptions will be allowed. The Lower Cape May Regional Board of Education reserves the right to approve all inscriptions. The School District cannot accept paver messages that contain political partisanship, or promotion or denigration of religion. Fonts will be chosen by The Lower Cape May Regional Education Foundation to maintain consistency with existing engraving.*

#### What is the size of the Pavers?

*Pavers are 4 inches by 8 inches.*

#### When will the pavers be installed?

*Pavers are installed using student volunteers in the spring and fall of each school year. The next installation will be in the spring of 2018.*

#### If my paver is damaged, will I receive a replacement?

*The pavers are made of stone, and, therefore, you should expect normal wear and tear. The Lower Cape May Regional Education Foundation will replace any paver with damage that affects the inscription or if the paver becomes a hazard to visitors, students or faculty.*

#### Can I request that my paver be placed next to someone else's?

*Yes, as long as both pavers are being dedicated during the same ceremony. Unfortunately, we cannot move prior placed pavers.*
