PROM ETIQUETTE

Since everyone wants everything to be perfect for you at the prom, we have developed some rules which may help it be the most perfect evening for you and your date.

- Too much preparation has been made prior to the prom to let drinking ruin your evening. It would be
 a humiliating ending to the prom if your parents had to be contacted to pick you up and drive you
 home because of alcohol or drug use. All students attending the prom will submit to an alcohol
 breathalyzer test prior to being admitted. Permission slips indicating this must be signed by a parent
 prior to purchasing your prom ticket.
- 2. Discuss the style and color of your attire with your date. This will help you in your purchase of flowers. Remember, this is a formal event which requires formal attire. For the young men, this means a tuxedo or a presentable suit and tie. For the young ladies, they should wear an appropriate formal dress or gown. Dress shoes are required. No sneakers or flip-flops. Anyone who wears any inappropriate attire or dresses in a manner which mocks the formality of the occasion will not be admitted to the prom.
- 3. Anyone bringing a date who is not a LCMR student must indicate so before they buy a prom ticket and must inform their Assistant Principal for approval. Special forms are available for this purpose and must be completed by your date. The form must be submitted to your Assistant Principal prior to purchasing your prom ticket.
- 4. Arrange transportation well in advance.
- 5. Remember to bring your prom ticket/invitation with you. It will be checked as you enter.
- 6. Pictures will be taken at the prom by a professional photographer. Package and price information is available through the Junior Class Advisor. Pictures will be taken at the prom throughout the evening.
- 7. There will be a receiving line for you to introduce yourself and your date to Mr. Ziemba, Mr. Schiffbauer, Mr. Daly and Mrs. Ford. The receiving line announcements begin at 7:00 p.m. Arriving too early means you are standing in line waiting for the doors to open at 7:00. Do not get involved in long conversations because it slows the process. You may choose <u>not</u> to participate in the receiving line, and may enter the prom without waiting.
- 8. The <u>After Prom Party</u> is being held at the high school. Activities, prizes, refreshments, and entertainment will be provided after the Prom until 5:00 a.m.
