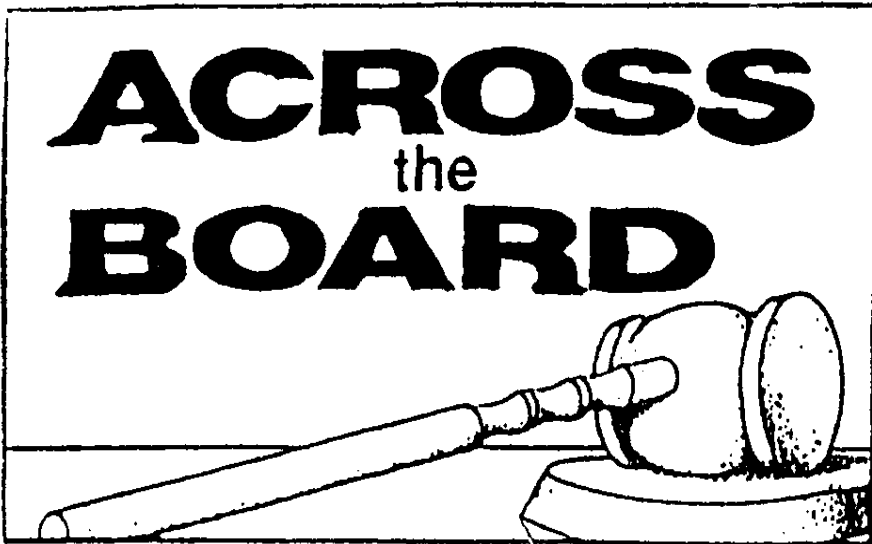

The Board approved:

The regular meeting minutes, executive session minutes, and work session minutes from the Board of Education meeting of January 24, 2011 .

The submission of the 2011/12 school district budget to the County Superintendent of Schools by March 4, 2011, and to apply for any statutory spending limitations as needed. The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools and the Business Administrator to make all necessary changes to the budget once all state aid is released by the Governor and the New Jersey Department of Education.

The anticipated tuition will be a total of \$11,319 plus \$11,170 for a total amount of \$22,489.
