

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your student may be enrolled in one or more dual credit courses at LCMR.

Dual credit courses allow students to earn both high school and college credit at the same time through Stockton University or Atlantic Cape Community College.

Please take time to read this packet carefully so you understand how the program works and can make the best decision for your student and family.

Important Note: If a student does not pass or earns a low grade in a dual credit course, that grade will appear on their official college transcript and could affect future college admissions or scholarship opportunities.

Atlantic Cape Community College Dual Credit Program Participation Steps

STEP 1: Apply for Admission

The deadline to apply for the Dual Credit in the 2025-26 academic year is November 30, 2025.

- Create an [application account](#) with Atlantic Cape to apply as an Early College student using “Choice #2 – Early College Application. *If you have previously applied as an Early College student, you do not need to reapply.*
- Once your application is submitted, you will receive an acceptance letter within 24 hours with instructions on how to access to your Atlantic Cape Connect student portal.

STEP 2: Register for Dual Credit

Registration for 2025-26 academic year dual credit courses will be open from January 15 - March 15, 2026.

- Click on the card/link to "Self-service"
- Select the "Academics" tab in self-service.
- Select "Student Planning"
- Select "Plan and Schedule"
- Where the term is listed, hit the arrow until the **2025 Fall High School Semester** shows
- Select "Register"

STEP 3: Make Payment and Earn College Credit

- Once you have registered, you will receive a prompt to make payment through the payment screen. Dual credit tuition is **\$68 per credit—a savings of nearly 60% off regular tuition!**
- If you received notice that a scholarship will be applied for your dual credit tuition, ignore the payment prompt. Your account will be cleared and you will receive an email that the scholarship has been applied. This can take up to a week.
