Approve the Township of Lower Parks & Recreation Department to use RMT Small Gym for its Youth Wrestling Program from February 2021 through March 2021, Saturdays from 9:00am-1:00pm, pending completed paperwork & required certificate of insurance with a policy endorsement. This is contingent upon no conflicts with our own school district activities. The participants must follow the District local/State Health Department/CDC protocols/requirements/recommendations. All further arrangements will be coordinated with Erik Simonsen and Roy Olsen.
- c. Approve the Cape May County Health Department to use the Field House as a Vaccination Site, from February 1, 2021 to June 1, 2021 (specific dates/times TBD), pending completed paperwork & required certificate of insurance with policy endorsement. This is contingent upon no conflicts with our own school district activities. The participants must follow the District local/State Health Department/CDC protocols/requirements/recommendations.
