ADDENDUM

FINANCE:

- a. Accept the 2nd Round of *Securing our Children's Future Bond Act Security Grant* for \$73,671. Funds will be used for Alyssa's Law Compliance and adding/upgrading surveillance cameras and servers for surveillance cameras, in addition to access controls into the schools. If the total estimated cost of the work exceeds the school district's grant allowance, the district has budgeted local funds for any additional costs.
- b. Accept the *Middle Grades Career Awareness Exploration Grant* for \$68,992. Lower Cape May Regional School District, in partnership with two other school districts, Lower Township Elementary School District & Cape May City School District, will use the grant to implement a Career Exploration Program for middle school students in grades 5-8.
- c. Approve submission of the FY22 ESEA Title I SIA Consolidated Grant for \$32,100.
- d. Approve the following school fundraising activity: RMT Student Government, Bake Sale 12/23/21.
- e. Approve John Drechen to attend the NJ Music Educator's Conference from February 24-26, 2022 in Atlantic City, NJ.
- f. Approve reimbursement to Brittany O'Donnell for 3 credits from Rowan University in the amount of \$2,631, as per contract.
- g. Approve the following resolution: On the recommendation of the Finance Committee, the 2020-2021 Audit is accepted, as presented by Inverso & Stewart (ADDENDUM FIN G).
- h. Approve Business Administrator/Board Secretary to go out to bid for replacement of the High School hallway lockers.
- i. Accept donation of \$2,000 from Mr. Alfred "Fred" Trassatti, Jr. to purchase a new shed for the LCMR 4H Beekeeping program.
