

**LOWER CAPE MAY REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT  
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING  
APRIL 28, 2022  
ADDENDUM**

FINANCE

- a. Approve Christopher Devlin and David Eakin to travel to Greensboro, NC for the Thomas Built Buses Technician Institute for mechanics training on May 16 – 21, 2022 at a cost not to exceed \$3200.00
- b. Approve renewal of the agreement with Dental Alliance effective July 1, 2022 (Addendum FIN B).
- c. Approve the following resolution to enter into a Water Supply & Distribution Agreement between the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority and the Lower Cape May Board of Education (Addendum FIN C).

**WHEREAS**, the Richard M. Teitelman Middle School failed to meet the drinking water standard for total coliform bacteria, which are naturally present in the environment, during routine quarterly testing on December 16, 2021, where one sample tested positive and all the others were negative, and

**WHEREAS**, because of one positive test, subsequent testing is required by state law to take four repeat samples, and on Wednesday, December 22, 2021, the District received notice that all by one repeat sample were positive for total coliform bacteria and negative for e-coli, which resulted in a “Do not drink notice”, and

**WHEREAS**, the District did not have in-person classes from January 3 to 10, 2022 due to the Richard M. Teitelman Middle School well having to be closed down and the need to connect the Middle School to the High School well, and

**WHEREAS**, the Richard M. Teitelman Middle School well was determined to need replacing, and the school is in an emergency situation where if the High School pump breaks, the district will be closed until the well can be working, and

**WHEREAS**, through discussions with the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority, there is an opportunity to connect to the Lower Township Municipal Utilities Authority public water supply to ensure safe water to drink and use for sanitation purposes, which will minimize virus transmission and exposure to health hazards, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Education of the Lower Cape May Regional School District, that the Board President and Business Administrator/Board Secretary are hereby authorized to enter into a Water Supply & Distribution Agreement between the Lower Township

Municipal Utilities Authority and the Lower Cape May Board of Education, is hereby approved at the Board of Education meeting held on this 28<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2022.

- d. Approve Joe Castellucci attending the May 18 - May 20 NJASA Spring Leadership Conference in Atlantic City, NJ.
- e. Authorize the Business Administrator, in conjunction with Garrison Architects, to go out for Request for Proposals for structural steel testing and inspection services for the HS Locker Room Renovations.
- f. Approve the use of 1 bus/driver to transport the West Cape May & Cape May City 6<sup>th</sup> Graders on May 31, 2022, to visit the Richard M. Teitelman School. All further arrangements will be coordinated with JoAnn Laputka.
- g. Approve the change of location of the West Cape May Elementary use of 1 bus/driver on May 6, 2022, to visit the Cape May County Zoo instead of the Misty Meadows Farm. This was approved at the March 17, 2022 Board Meeting.

#### CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

- a. Approve receipt of the County Office of Education's District Performance Review of the NJQSAC District Improvement Plan for Instruction & Program (Addendum CURR A).

#### POLICY

- a. Approve the Agreement with the County of Cape May (County) and the Board of Education of the Lower Cape May Regional School District (LCMR) for LCMR to provide the County with bus transportation services to assist in the evacuation of the County in the event of a natural disaster or other emergency that requires evacuation of the County (Addendum POL A).

- d. Approve the amended Employment Agreement that was reviewed and approved by the Interim Executive County Superintendent for Joseph A. Castellucci, Superintendent from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2024 (Addendum PERS D).

## BUILDINGS & GROUNDS

- a. Approve the Lower Cape May Little League to use the High School baseball fields and Field House, days & times to be determined based on availability, to hold baseball games and practices. This is contingent upon no conflicts with our own school district activities. The participants must follow the District local/State Health Department/CDC protocols/requirements/recommendations. The capacity of people attending and participating will be based on CDC, state and local guidelines. All further arrangements will be coordinated with Erik Simonsen and Roy Olsen.
- b. Approve the Casiello Basketball to use Both RMT Gyms for their Basketball Tournament on Saturday June 4 and Sunday June 5, 2022 from 8:00am – 6:00pm. This is subject to facility availability and contingent upon no conflicts with our own school district activities. Participants must follow the District, local/State Health Department and CDC protocols/requirements/recommendations. The capacity of people attending and participating will be based on CDC, state and local guidelines. All further arrangements will be coordinated with Erik Simonsen and Roy Olsen.
- c. Approve the Bill O'Neill Soccer LLC, under the direction of Bill O'Neill and Dennis Elia, to use the High School & RMT soccer fields on June 20-23, 2022 from 9:00am -12:00pm for Kids Soccer Camp and August 15-18, 2022 from 9:00am -12:00pm for High School Prep Camp. This is contingent upon receipt of required certificate of insurance with policy endorsement and no conflicts with our own school district activities. Participants must follow the District, local/State Health Department and CDC protocols/requirements/recommendations. The capacity of people attending and participating will be based on CDC, state and local guidelines. All further arrangements to be coordinated with Erik Simonsen and Roy Olsen.
