

**LOWER CAPE MAY REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING
AUGUST 25, 2022
ADDENDUM**

FINANCE

- a. Approve the 22-23 Transportation Contract with the New Jersey Department of Children and Families for student DR at a rate of \$75/per day, to transport to the DCF Regional School, Cape May Campus, Cape May Court House.

- b. Approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, On June 30, 2022, Governor Phil Murphy signed the Fiscal Year 2023 (FY2023) state budget. Pursuant to language included in the FY 2023 Appropriations Act, P.L. 2022 c.49, a district experiencing the following conditions in FY 2023 may apply for stabilization aid:

- The district experienced a reduction in state aid; or
- The district faces a structural budgetary imbalance

WHEREAS, On August 10, 2022, the NJ Department of Education issued a memo regarding the process for submitting an application for Stabilization Aid,

WHEREAS, Lower Cape May Regional School District has seen its State Aid reduced by \$5,384,448 from FY 2019 to FY 2023 due to S-2,

WHEREAS, the impact of S-2 on the Lower Cape May Regional will be an overall loss of State Aid of over \$6.5 million, with another nearly \$1.2 million loss over the FY24-FY25 school years. The District would utilize the \$4,531,592 to replace certain staff as they retire and not eliminate educational programs such AP, CTE and SLE programs, and to purchase new textbooks for Science and Social Studies for the high school and middle school to keep current with the on-line components offered and new learning standards. In addition, it would be used to continue the District's one-on-one Chromebook initiative for all students. The majority of this grant is anticipated to be used to maintain the District's facilities, which are 50+ years old, by replacing high school roofs at the end of their useful life and other maintenance/capital projects, such renovating the 50 year old middle school boys and girls locker rooms, replacing the 50 year old middle school corridor lockers, replacing the public address systems at the high school and middle school, asbestos remediation, replacing 45+ year old football/baseball field lights and football bleachers/press box, and replacing the sewer lines and valves and domestic water lines that are over 60 years old.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Lower Cape May Regional School District, that the submission by the Superintendent for Stabilization Aid application for up to \$4,531,592, is hereby approved at the Board of Education meeting held on this 25th day of August, 2022.
