






 MARIANNE: **Il y a cinq pièces.** There are five rooms.




There are four ways to write "the":
le (in front of a masculine singular noun)
la (in front of a feminine singular noun)
l' (in front of noun that begins with a vowel)
les (in front of a plural noun)
 The word **jardin** can mean "yard," as well as "garden."




Hospitality is part of French culture. Being gracious to one's guests includes making them feel at home.
