1. You are walking in town with your French friend Catherine. Catherine waves hello to a girl on a bicycle.

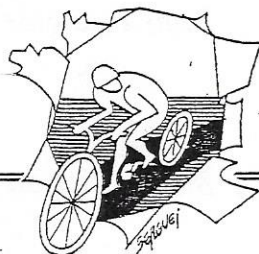
Ask Catherine who it is.

The American cyclist Greg Lemond is a three-time winner of the **Tour de France**.
