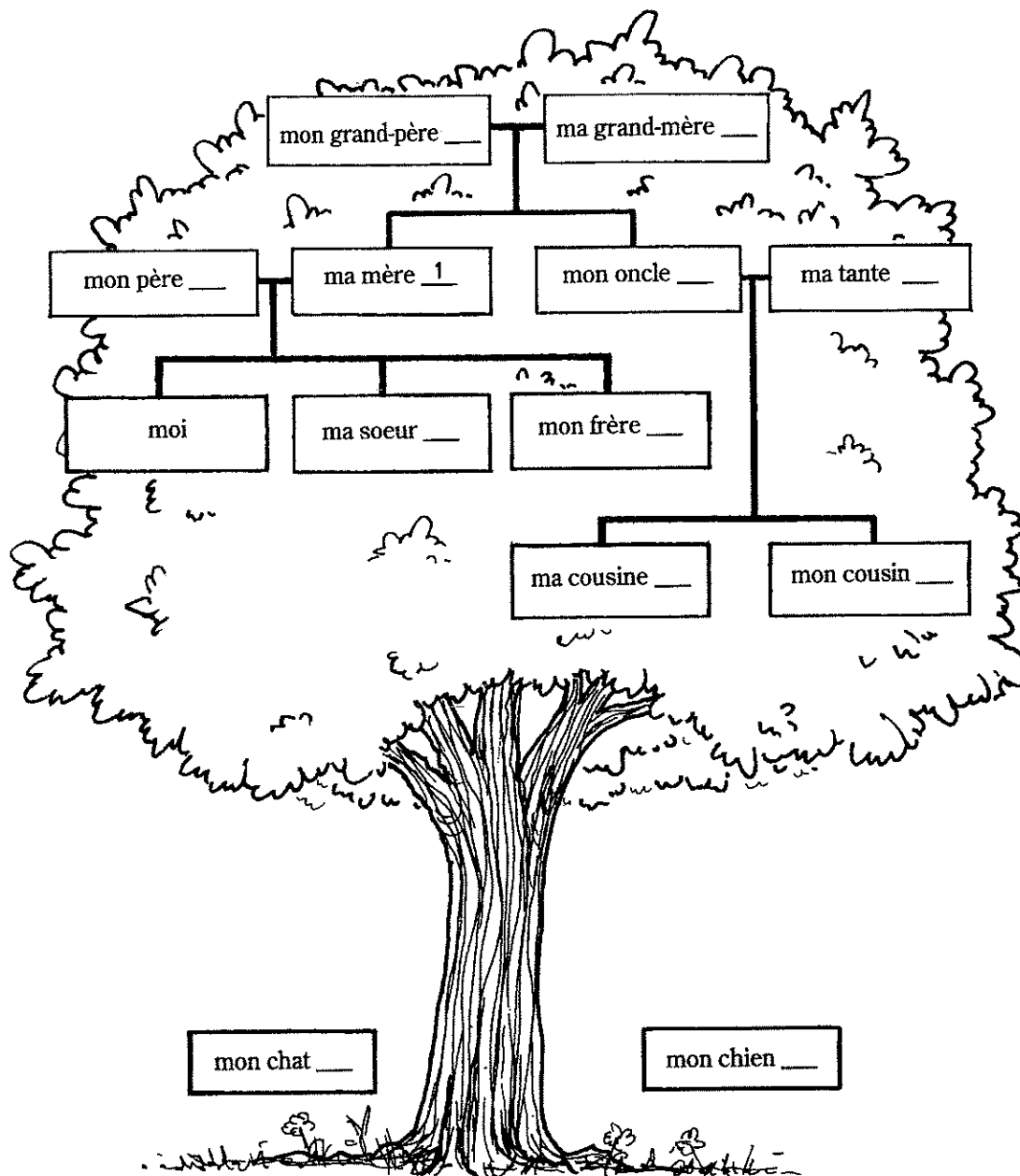
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2c.2 Activité 2. La famille d'Isabelle

(NOTE: The first item has been done for you.)

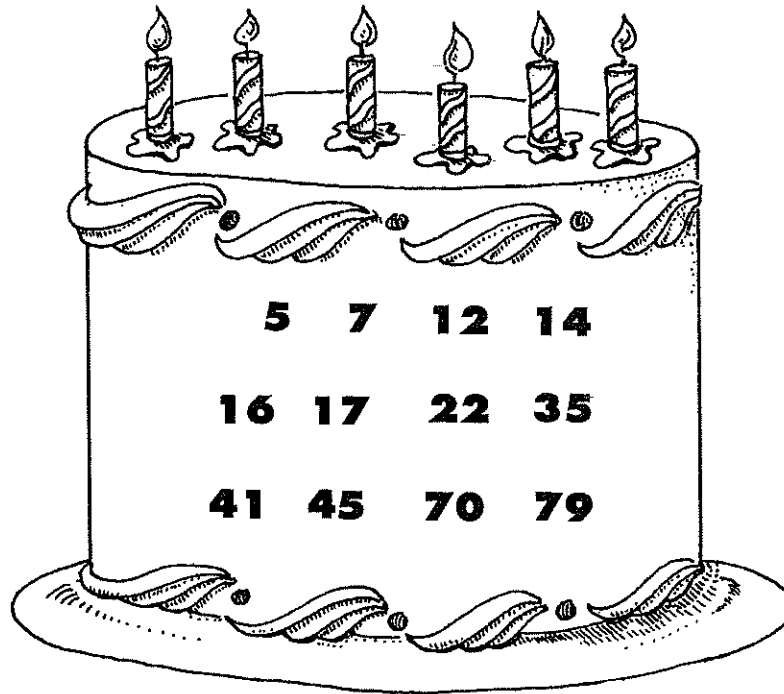


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2c.3 Activité 3. Quel âge ont-ils? (*How old are they?*)

After watching the **Vignette culturelle**, list the similarities and differences between Charlotte's wedding and a marriage ceremony you have attended.

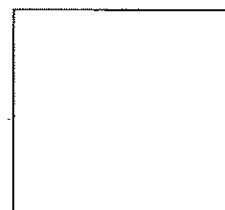
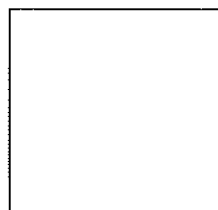
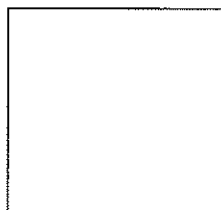
