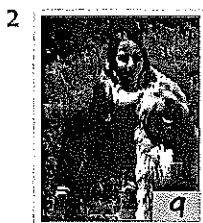

5 En scène

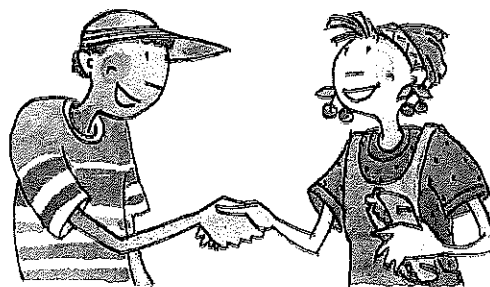
PARLER With a classmate, act out the following scene.
