

Spanish Dual Credit- Honors Spanish III and Honors Spanish IV

Students who take Honors Spanish III or Honors Spanish IV will have the opportunity to earn college credit that may be transferred to the college of their choice after graduating high school.

Students may take these courses without opting for the portable credits and only receive high school credit.

If students choose to earn college credit, they will have to complete this form and pay for the credits at the beginning of October. The cost for the high school student is a fraction of what college students pay.

Those who take Honors Spanish III may enroll in LS102 for 3 credits through Cumberland County College. Those who take Honors Spanish IV may enroll in LS201 for 3 credits through Cumberland County College. The cost for each course is \$120.

The forms for enrolling will be completed in school at the end of September and the checks, made payable to Cumberland County College, will be due on **October 15th**.
