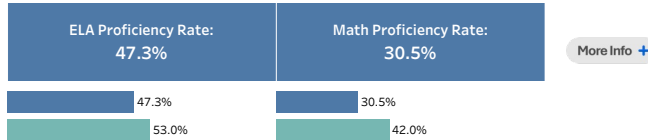

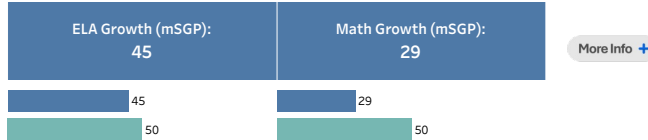
The following section shows performance across a variety of measures. The box shows the 2024-25 performance for all students in the district. The bars below the box compare the school performance with statewide performance.

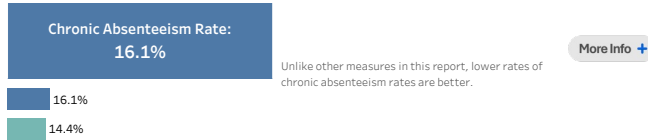
Proficiency on Statewide Assessments
 Proficiency rates measure the percentage of students who met or exceeded expectations on the statewide assessments (NJSLA and DLM).



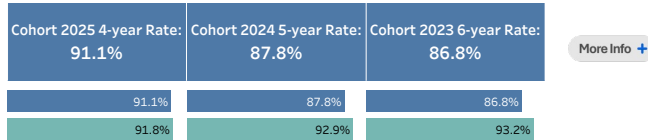
Student Growth
 Student growth is measured by median student growth percentiles (mSGPs) in English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics.



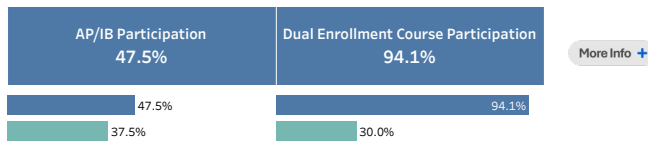
Chronic Absenteeism
 Chronic absenteeism rates measure the percentage of K-12 students who were absent for 10% or more of the days they were enrolled during the school year.



Graduation Rates
 Adjusted cohort graduation rates measure the percentage of students who graduated within four, five, and six years of entering high school.



Advanced Coursework
 This shows the percentage of 11th and 12th graders who were enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) courses or dual enrollment courses during the school year.



Seal of Bilingual Proficiency
 The New Jersey State Seal of Bilingual Proficiency is an award given to recognize students who have studied and attained proficiency in at least one language in addition to English by high school graduation.



Career and Technical Education
 This shows information on the percentage of high school students enrolled in approved Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs and the percentage of students in those programs who earned industry-valued credentials during the school year.
